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I. PRESS AND NGO ARRANGEMENTS

1. Summit Meeting Premises

The venue of the CSCE Budapest Summit Meeting is the Patria Hall in the Budapest Convention Centre, which is also the site of the ongoing Budapest Review Conference

2. Accreditation and Security Arrangements

Accreditation for the CSCE Review Conference is not valid for the Summit. Those attending the Summit should obtain a **new Summit badge** from the Executive Secretariat, displaying the holder's photograph.

For security reasons access to the Budapest Summit Meeting premises is restricted to persons wearing a Summit badge

Press and NGO accreditation forms have been distributed from 1 November onwards through the diplomatic missions of the CSCE participating States, the CSCE offices and the Budapest Summit Executive Secretariat. The forms, which can be freely multiplied, should be returned with two passport size photographs to the Summit Executive Secretariat as soon as possible. As registration and the production of the special holomagnetic badge take quite a few minutes, those wishing to get accreditation on 5 December may run the risk of missing events.

Badges should be collected in person, on presentation of the identification documents indicated on the accreditation form

Issueing of the Summit accreditation badges starts on 30 November at the Budapest Convention Centre.

3. Press Centre

3.1 The Summit Press/Information and NGO Centre is located in the Cultural House of the Hungarian Optical Works (MOM), approximately 200 metres from the Budapest Convention Centre (see Plan of Premises)

The following **facilities** are available to the press information desks with official documents of the event and notices about press opportunities, a working area and technical and telecommunications equipment (typewriters, photo-copiers, card-operated telephone and fax machines, 12 radio commentator booths). In view of the large numbers of media covering the Summit, the more independently of the Press Centre you can work, the better, as there will be at times considerable pressure on the facilities

Telephone/fax cards can be purchased at the service counters of the Hungarian Post Office in the Press Centre and the foyer of the Budapest Convention Centre

Proceedings of the plenary meetings can be followed on a video screen in the **Theatre Hall** of the building (seating 800), with simultaneous interpretation in the six official CSCE languages. The plenary meetings can also be covered from the gallery of Pátria

Hall in the Budapest Convention Centre The use of interpretation of speeches must remain limited to strictly non-commercial purposes of public information, meaning immediate news coverage only

These facilities are available for accredited journalists and NGO representatives only

3.2 Facilities for News Agencies

A limited number of offices are set up for News Agencies on the 2nd floor in the Budapest Convention Centre, near the entrance to the gallery of the Pátria Hall Allocation of the office space and technical facilities was handled by the Hungarian News Agency (MTI) upon requests submitted earlier

4. Press Opportunities

4.1 The plenary meetings of the Summit (see Summit Schedule) will be **open** The **gallery of the Pátria Hall** in the Budapest Convention Centre (entrance on the 2nd floor), seating approx 700, will be reserved for accredited representatives of the press and the non-governmental organizations, where they can follow proceedings with the aid of simultaneous interpretation in the six official CSCE languages **Important:** as delegations will be given priority at security between 8 00 - 9 00hrs, journalists and NGO representatives should arrive before 8 00hrs in order to guarantee places in the Press Gallery The doors of the Convention Centre will open at 6 00hrs on 5 and 6 December

Due to the limited capacity of the gallery, the plenary meetings can also be seen on a video screen located in the **Theatre Hall** (capacity 800 persons) of the **Press/Information** and **NGO Centre**, with simultaneous interpretation in the six official CSCE languages

- **4.2** A final **press conference** will be held by the CSCE Troika after the Closing Ceremony on 6 December, in the Theatre Hall of the Press/Information and NGO Centre
- **4.3** All other **press briefings and conferences** are organized upon request from the delegations with the assistance of the Press Service of the Executive Secretariat Bookings should be made in writing to the Press Service Rooms available for this purpose on a first-come first-served basis are the Bartók Hall (300 persons) in the Budapest Convention Centre, the Theatre Hall (800 persons) at the Press/Information and NGO Centre, and a press room (80 persons) in the nearby Fotex Plaza building, at 47 Csorsz utca

Announcements of press briefings and conferences will be displayed at the Press/Information and NGO Centre and the Budapest Convention Centre.

4.4 Requests for **interviews** should be made directly to the offices of the delegations and organizations located in the Hotel Novotel (see Useful Numbers) The Press Service cannot handle individual interview requests

4.5 Photo opportunities

VIP arrivals and departures at the airport can only be covered by Hungarian Television (MTV) and the Hungarian News Agency (MTI) No other media will be present at the airport. There will be no statements to the press there Also, only MTV and MTI will be admitted to cover the beginning of the working luncheon at the Hilton Hotel and of the gala dinner in the parliament on the 5th.

In view of the expected media interest and the limited space, all other photo opportunities, except the final press conference, are **pooled** The Press Service cannot guarantee admittance to all opportunities requested. Information about **pool positions** is available on separate sheets.

Pool cards can be collected from 3 December onwards at the desk near the security checkpoint off the main entrance to the Budapest Convention Centre. Pool positions, especially arrivals, should be taken up 1 hour before the event

All main events and all pool positions will be covered by MTV Hungarian Television and MTI Hungarian News Agency (stills). Plenary sessions will be covered by Hungarian Television camera crews only. For technical services offered, see No 5 on page 6.

5.2 Television Services

BETA SP editing facilities are available with EBU and at MTV headquarters on a booking basis

MTV/EBU can provide studio and stand-up positions on a booking basis

Plenary sessions will be covered by MTV camera crews only. The pool signal is available by request from MTV or EBU

5.3 Radio Services

12 commentator booths for live reports and transmission of recordings will be available at the Press Centre

6. Transport and Parking Facilities

6.1 On 5-6 December, shuttle bus services will operate between the Budapest Convention Centre and the following major hotels designated for the Summit Forum, Gellert, Hilton, Hyatt, Kempinski, Mariott and Penta Summit badge holders accommodated in these hotels are entitled to take the shuttle buses. Timetable of their operation is available on the spot

6.2 The parking area of the Budapest Convention Centre is reserved for the VIP motorcades. For the press and the NGOs, a parking area is provided around the Press and NGO Centre where a limited number of cars can be accommodated (see Plan of Premises). Press car passes will be available in the Budapest Convention Centre from 2 December onwards

7. Information for Those in the VIP Escort

7.1 In case of arrival by special or scheduled flight at Budapest Ferihegy Airport, the motorcades designated for the delegations and other cars provided by the diplomatic missions to transport the delegation members will proceed directly to the plane Following the official welcome the Head of State or Government and members of the official delegation will proceed to the motorcade. All other persons in the escort, including experts and journalists, will be transported to their place of accommodation by vehicles provided by their respective missions. These vehicles will directly follow the official motorcade.

7.2 Luggage, Passport and Transport Arrangements

Representatives of the Protocol Department of the Hungarian Foreign Ministry and the Government Guard, in close co-operation with the airport authorities, will be responsible for the luggage of the delegations. Luggage vans will be provided by the host country A member of the delegation or a representative of the Mission concerned is requested to accompany the luggage.

For purposes of luggage identification members of the delegation and the escort are kindly requested to use the stickers issued by the host country.

The passports of the Heads of State or Government and members of the delegations will not be examined. Members of the delegations and other persons arriving for the Summit by scheduled flights are advised to disembark from the plane with the Head of State or Government

7.3 Those arriving for the Summit separately from the official delegations are advised to use the corridor marked with the "CSCE" logo where they will be given special speedy treatment by the Passport and Customs Authorities.

7.4 Departure from Budapest

The Heads of State or Government and their immediate escort should be ready to leave for the airport half an hour (30 minutes) prior to the flight's scheduled departure Their motorcade will proceed directly to the plane.

Members of the delegation and others (including experts and journalists) **not** travelling in the official motorcade will be transported to the airport prior to the departure of the Head of State or Government from the latter's place of accommodation, in vehicles provided by their respective mission. They should be at the airport **one** (1) **hour before** the scheduled time of departure. The time of departure from the place of accommodation will be communicated by the permanent liaison officer

The luggage and air tickets of those leaving in the escort of the Head of State or Government will be collected by a representative of the host country at the place of residence of the Head of State or Government at least three hours before the flight's scheduled time of departure. The luggage and air tickets will be delivered to the airport by the representative of the host country

For security reasons all packages will be examined by an X-ray system

Members of the delegation, except for those travelling in the motorcade, have to undergo the usual airport security check.

8. Other Services

8.1 Several services are available for accredited representatives of the press and NGOs in the **foyer** of the Budapest Convention Centre. For telephone numbers, see Useful Numbers.

Right of the Main Entrance:

The Hungarian Foreign Trade Bank Ltd offers money exchange, cash advances for Eurocard, Mastercard and Visa cards, cashing of Eurocheques, immediate cashing of personal cheques up to the equivalent of USD 500, and cashing of travellers cheques.

The Hungarian Tourist Board's information agency **Tourinform** offers tourist information, guide books, maps, posters and English-language theatre and concert programmes. They are ready to organise individual excursions and provide theatre or concert tickets.
